Conservation and Coastal Management Element

Protect and preserve wetlands is the most important objective

Policy 5.07.05 should be expanded to ensure that the “water table level” in addition to “water quality” is maintained. The “water table level” should be maintained for the entire island in order to avoid salt water encroachment.

Long term goal to restrict public/private partnerships on the Riverfront

Limit development according to evacuation times so that new development impacts are accumulated yearly

Conservation land can be sold by referendum only

Aggressive and punitive action for tree removal

Define green sustainable building standards so they can be enforced

Stronger regulations than State SJRWMD for land and property development

Manage internal assets (trees) of Bosque Bella with fertilization and mulching- keep machinery away from base of trees

Aggressive climate change resiliency planning

Shift building off the beach

The City shall not convert, abandon, trade, or sell any land designated conservation or allow development on land designated conservation on the Future Land Use Map (Consensus)

Give careful consideration to the economic impact of the increased regulation or passing restrictions above the Florida Building Code or FDEP or SJRWMD regulations or rules.

Calculate the impact on tax millage rate on any of the ideas brought up during the 4/29/19 public input session
