B. Meeting Summary

- 1. The minutes of the February 20, 2013 meeting were accepted by general consensus of committee members.
- The Chair presented a video and website of a LEED Platinum home in Jacksonville, rebuilt after extensive flooding, to remind the committee the importance of our work.
- 3. **Presentation:** George Porter of JEA presented on how JEA water and sewer systems work. There was a lively question and answer period. Mr. Porter agreed to allow his presentation to be posted to the website, and the committee thanked him for his contribution to RCI policy work.
- 4. Margo Moehring provided a handout and discussed the approach to community resiliency assessments. After her presentation, the committee made the following changes to the proposed approach, by show of hands majority vote.
 - a. The committee agreed to do assessment maps for 1', 3', and 6' of rise. While the guidance the committee had given in February was for 1', 2', and 6' of rise, it was decided to use 3' to be consistent with the level being considered in work related to Matanzas Basin. The other alternative discussed was to use 2' in the other counties and 3' in Flagler and St. Johns, but the committee decided against this.
 - b. The committee refined the target audience for assessments to local government staff and representatives.
 - c. The committee removed background questions in the proposed assessment approach related to climate change, agreeing that this was outside of the committee scope.
- 5. Margo reported that an insurance-related contact has agreed to present to the committee. (*See post meeting update, below.)
- 6. The committee confirmed by majority show of hands that it wants to meet in April. Margo was asked to schedule a speaker who could address lessons learned from the SE Climate Compact or another Florida area that is further advanced in planning than Northeast Florida. (**See post meeting update, below.)
- 7. There was no public comment, as there was no public attendance.
- 8. The meeting was adjourned at 4:30pm.

C. Action Items

- 1. The following items will take place before the next meeting:
 - a. Margo and the Chair will invite local governments to participate in community resiliency assessments.
 - b. Margo will inform the committee when the invitations go out, so committee members can reach out to encourage participation if they choose.
 - c. Assessment schedule will be shared with committee members, so they may attend if they want.
