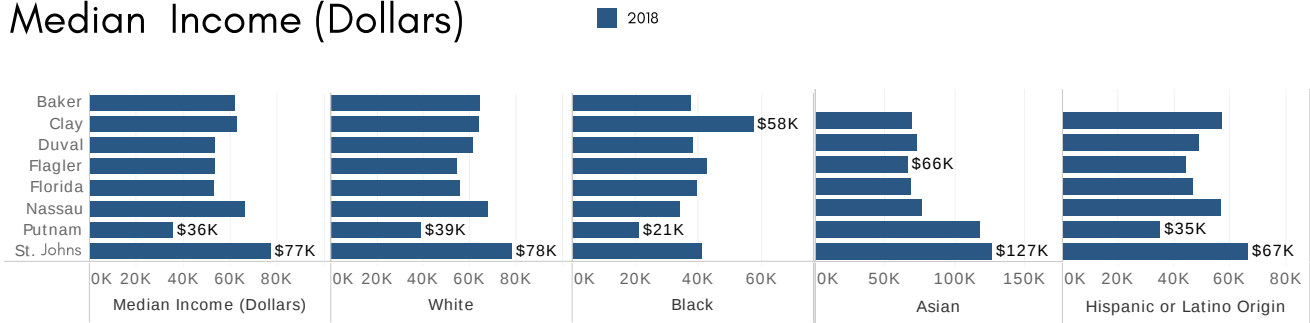

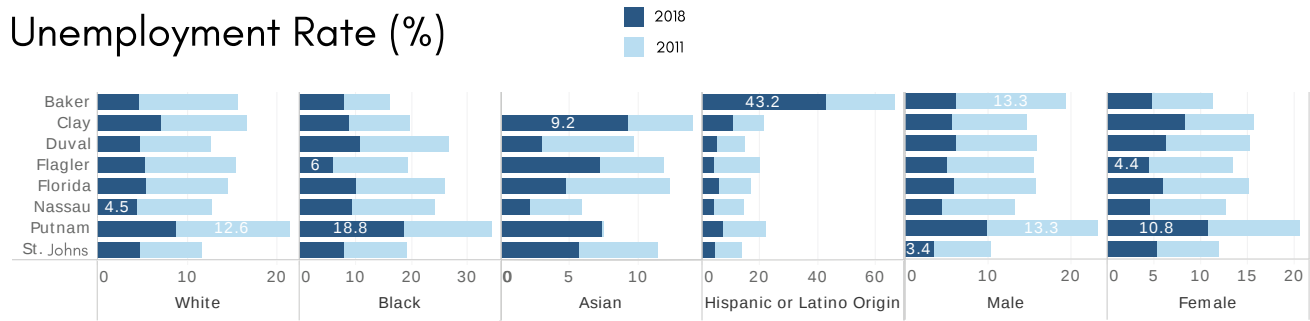
By Race (2018)



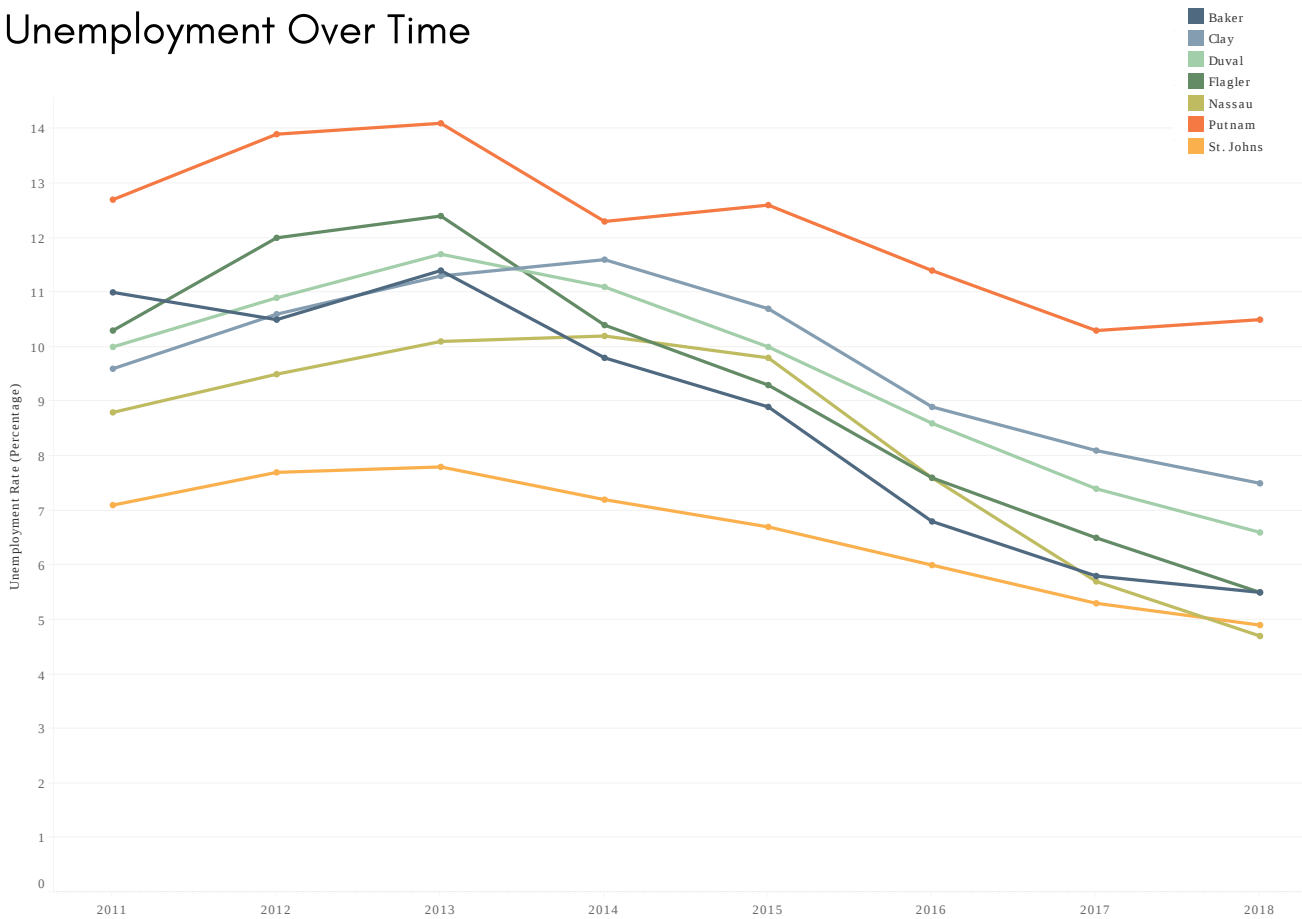

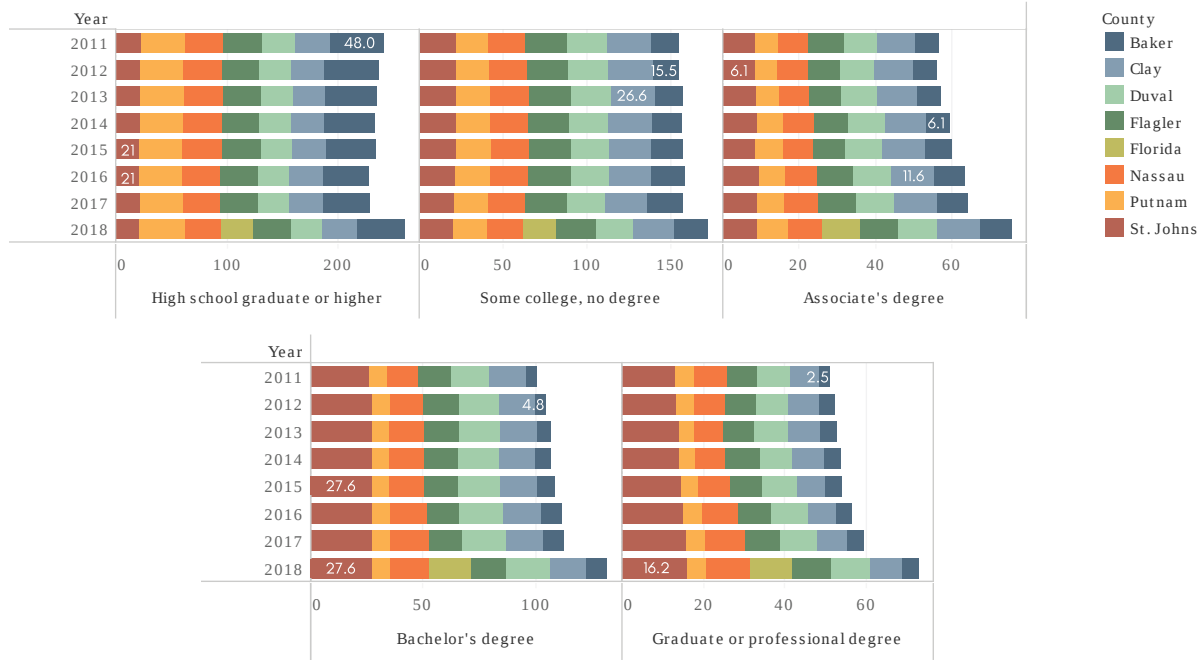
Unemployment Rate (%)



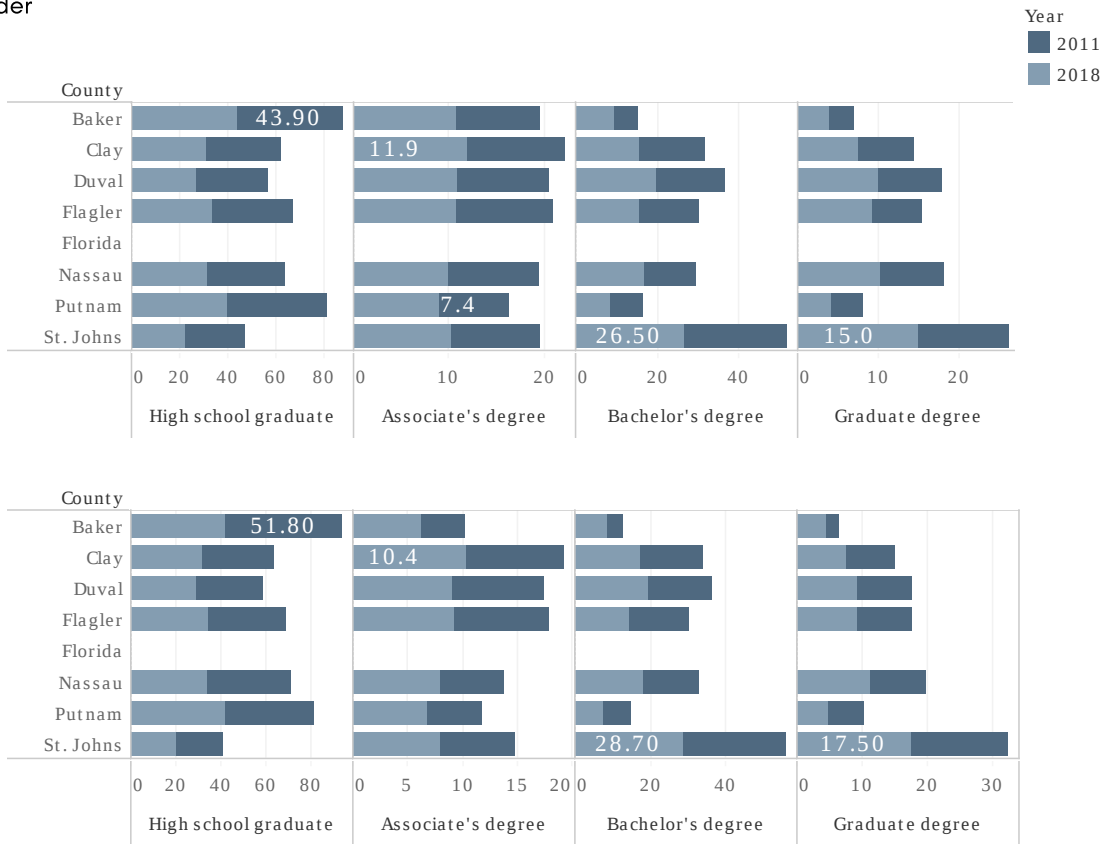
Unemployment Over Time



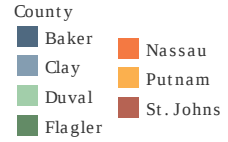
Educational Attainment (% of Population)



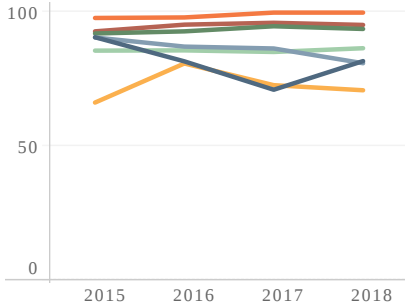

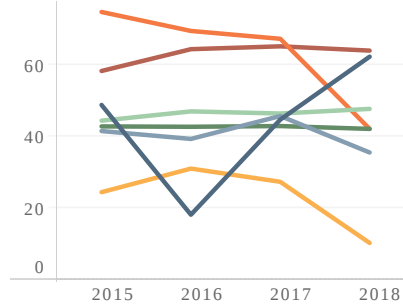

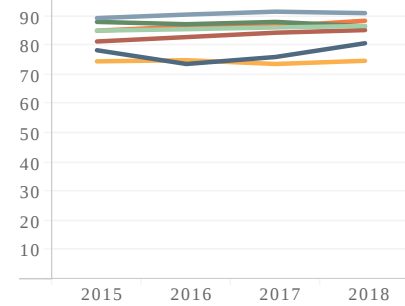

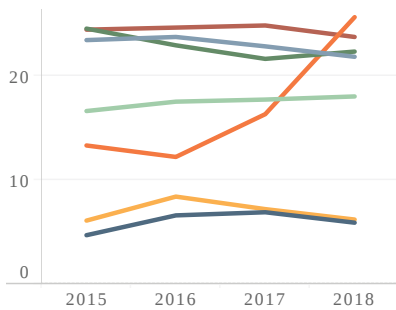

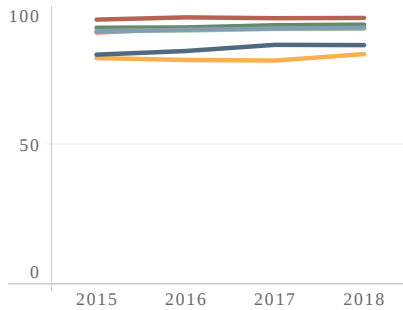

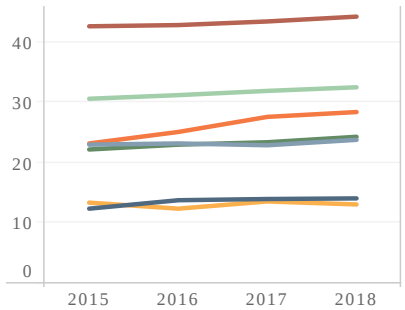

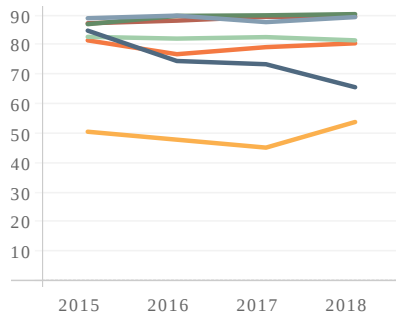

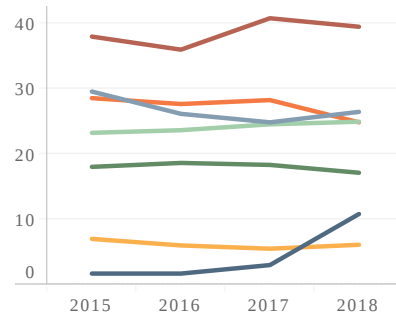

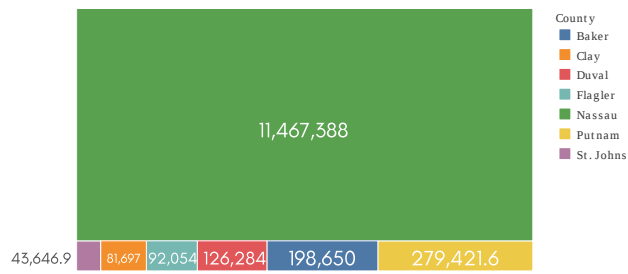

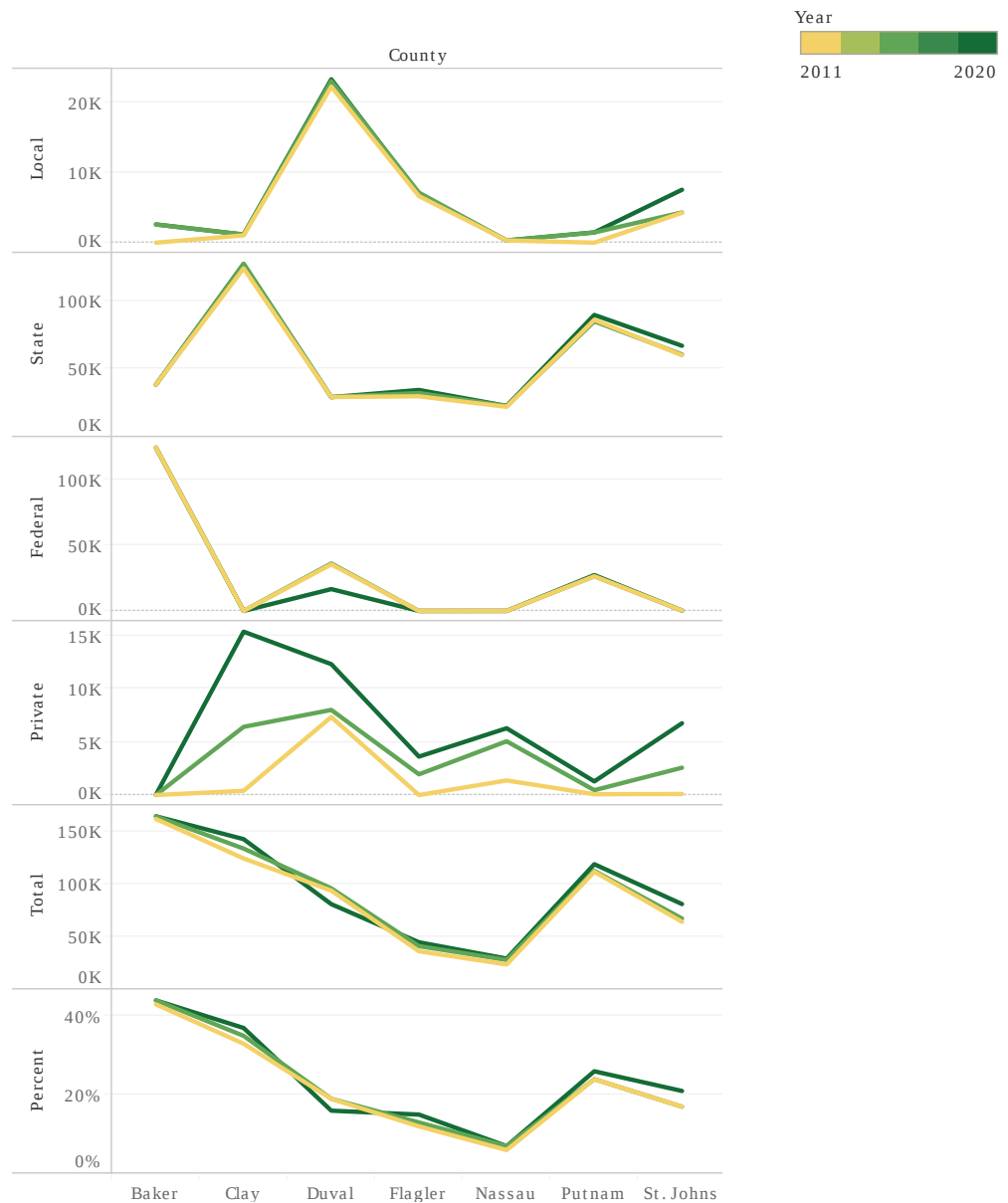

Agriculture Land Use by Acreage (2020)



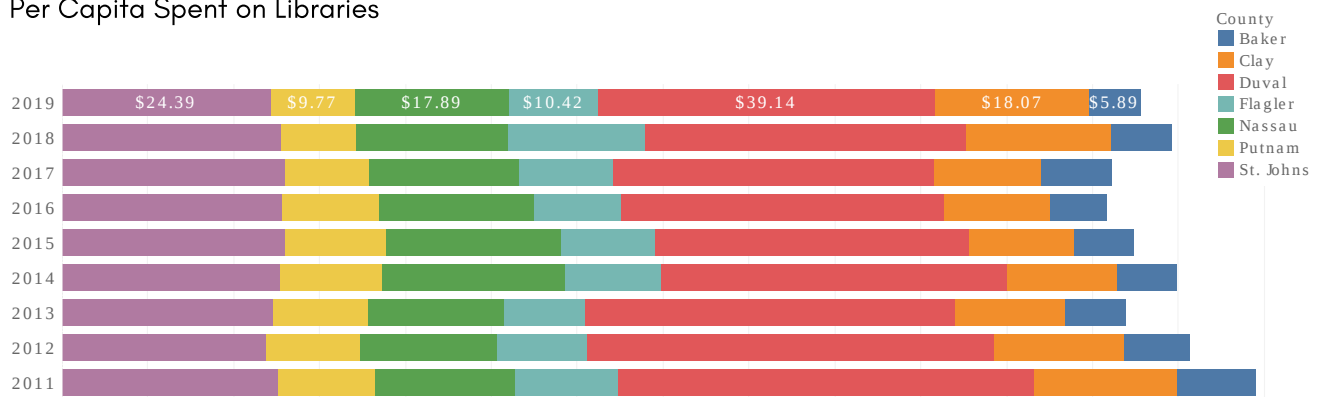

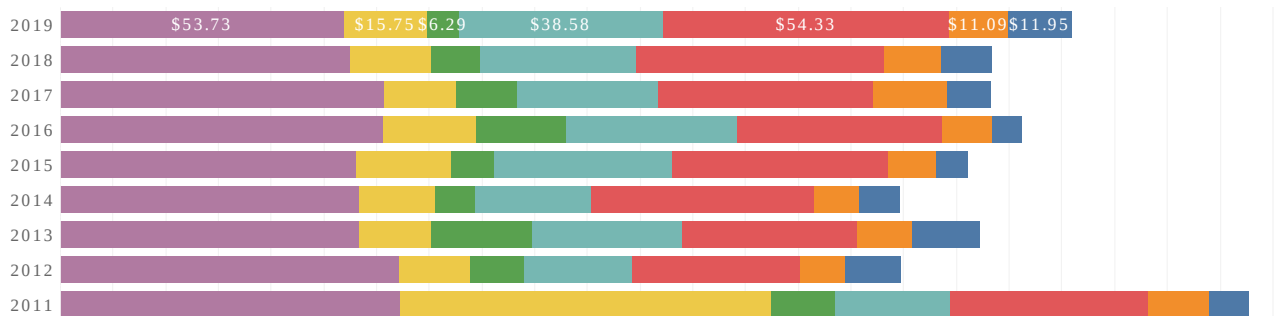

Per Capita Spent on Parks and Recreation

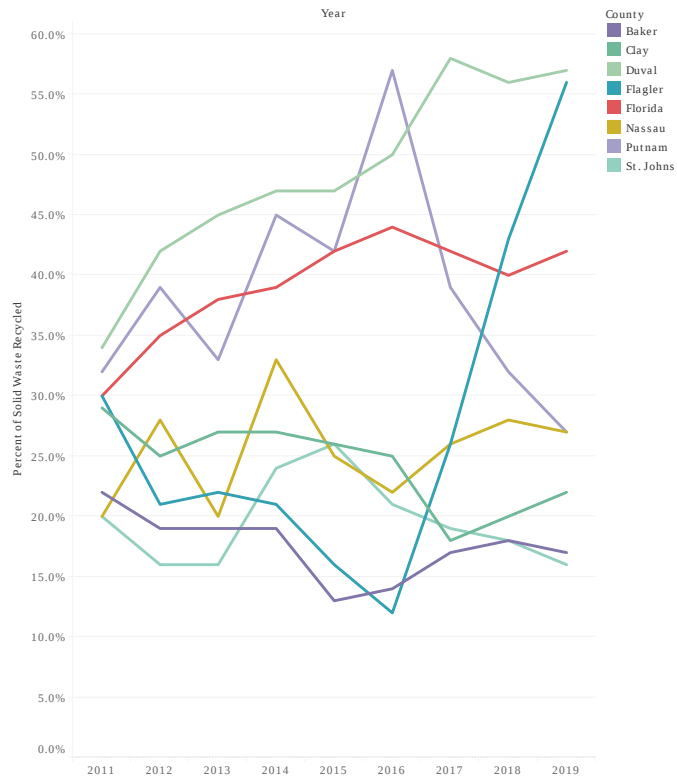

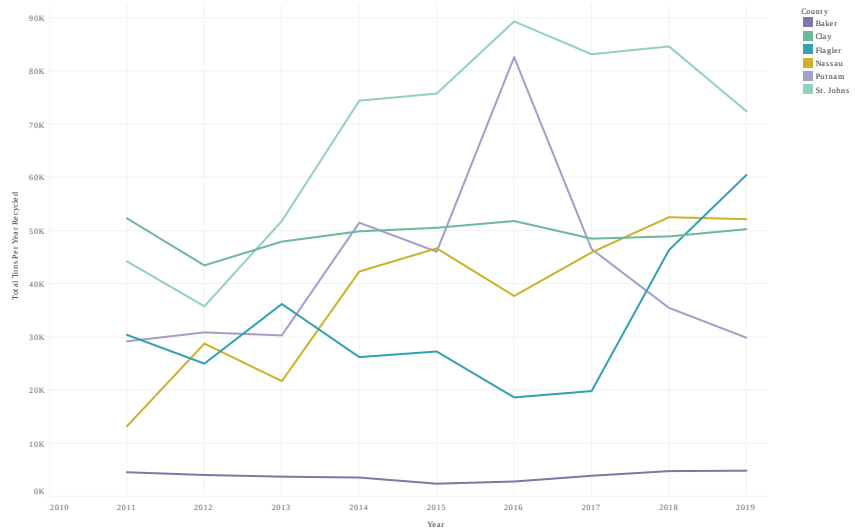

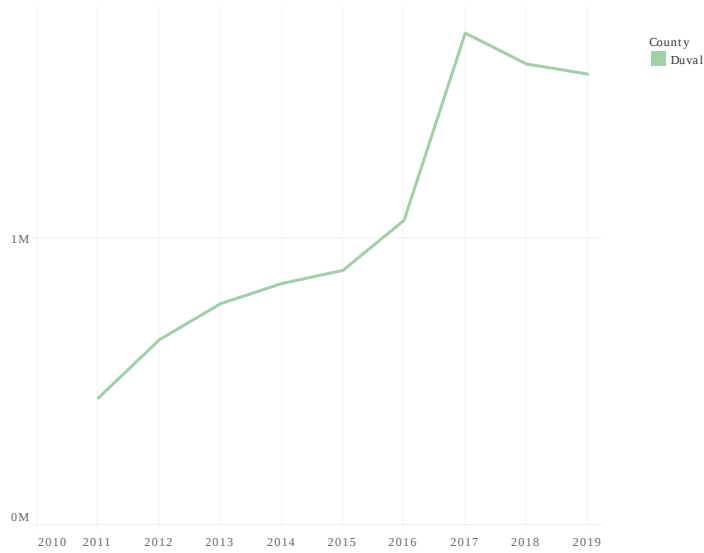
Percent of Solid Waste Recycled



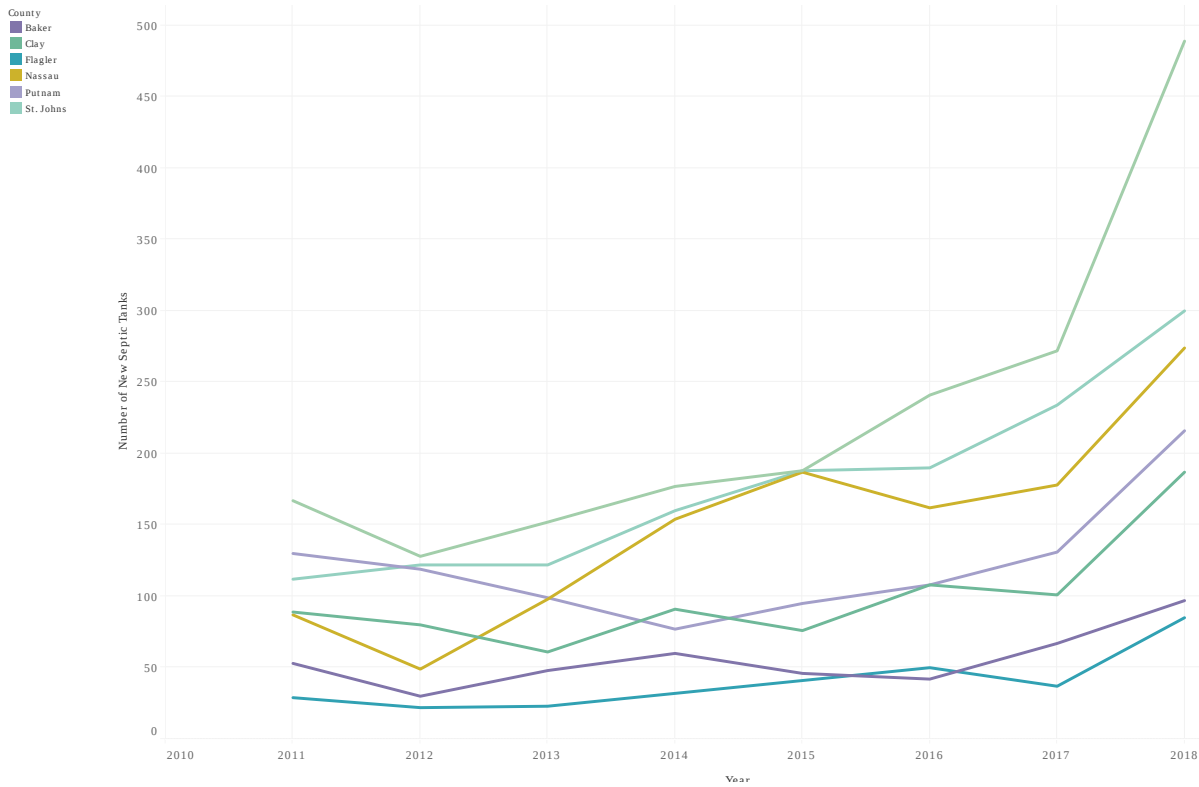
Total Tons Per Year Recycled



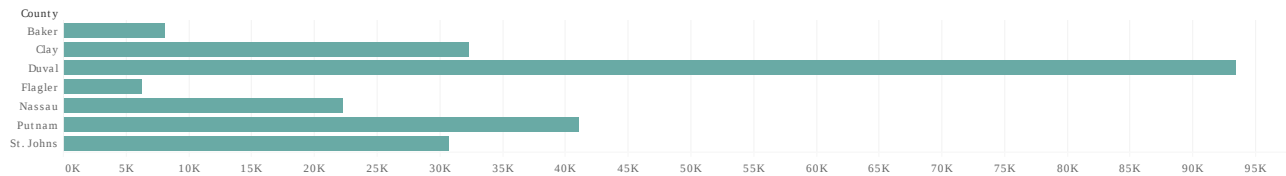
Total Tons Per Year Recycled (Duval)



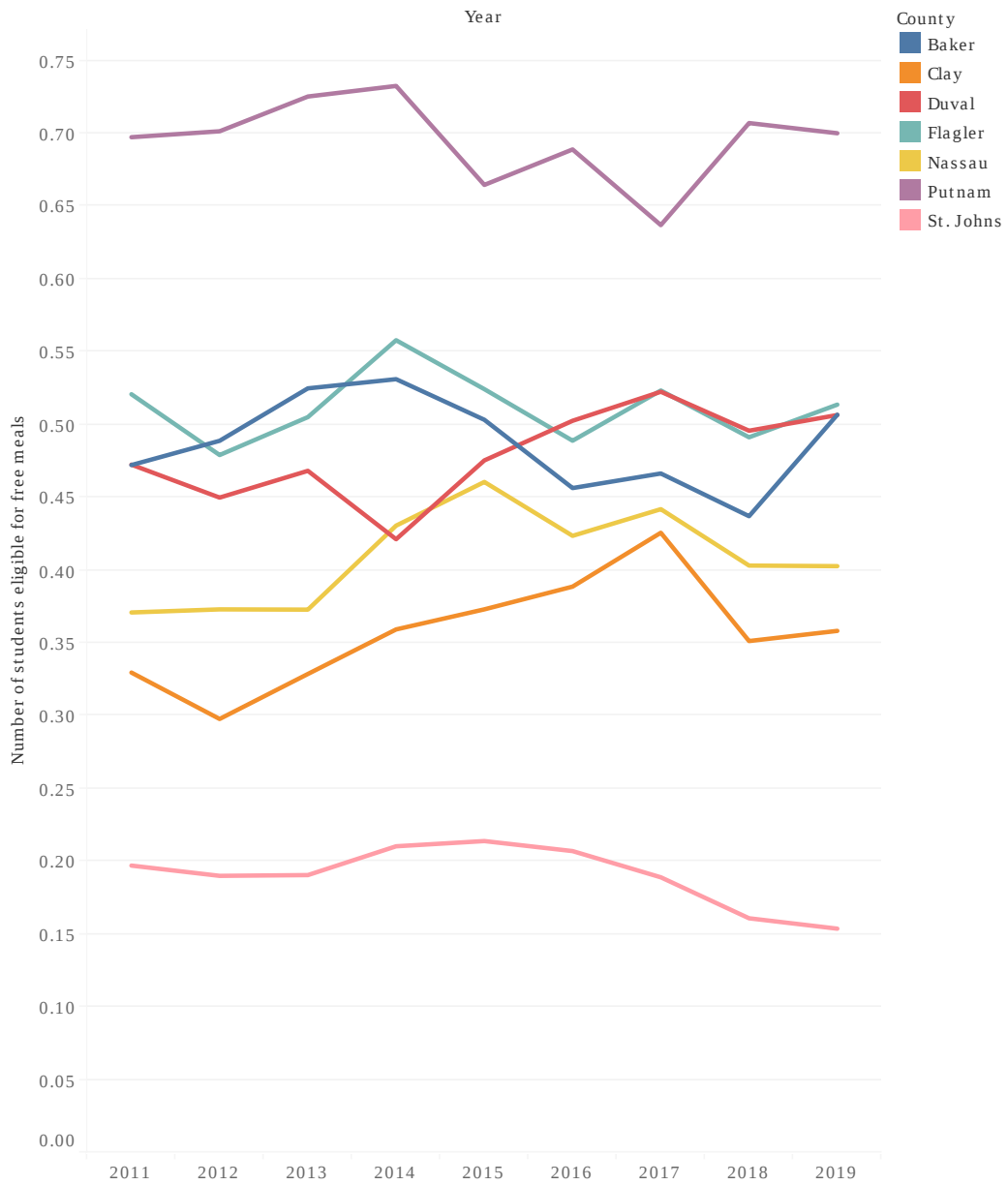
Number of New Septic Tanks



Total of Septic Tanks (Cumulative)



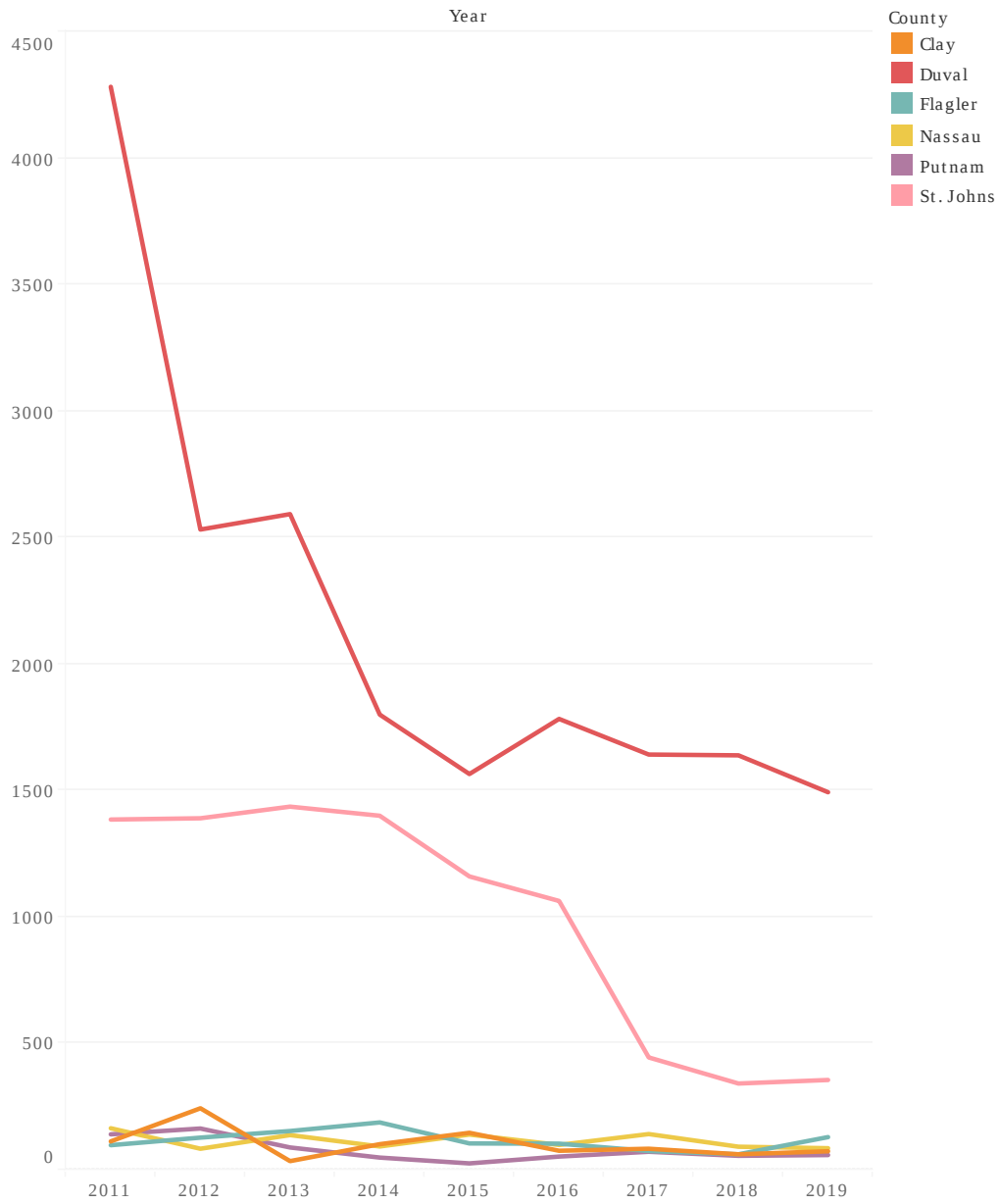
Number of Students Eligible for Free Meals (Per Capita)

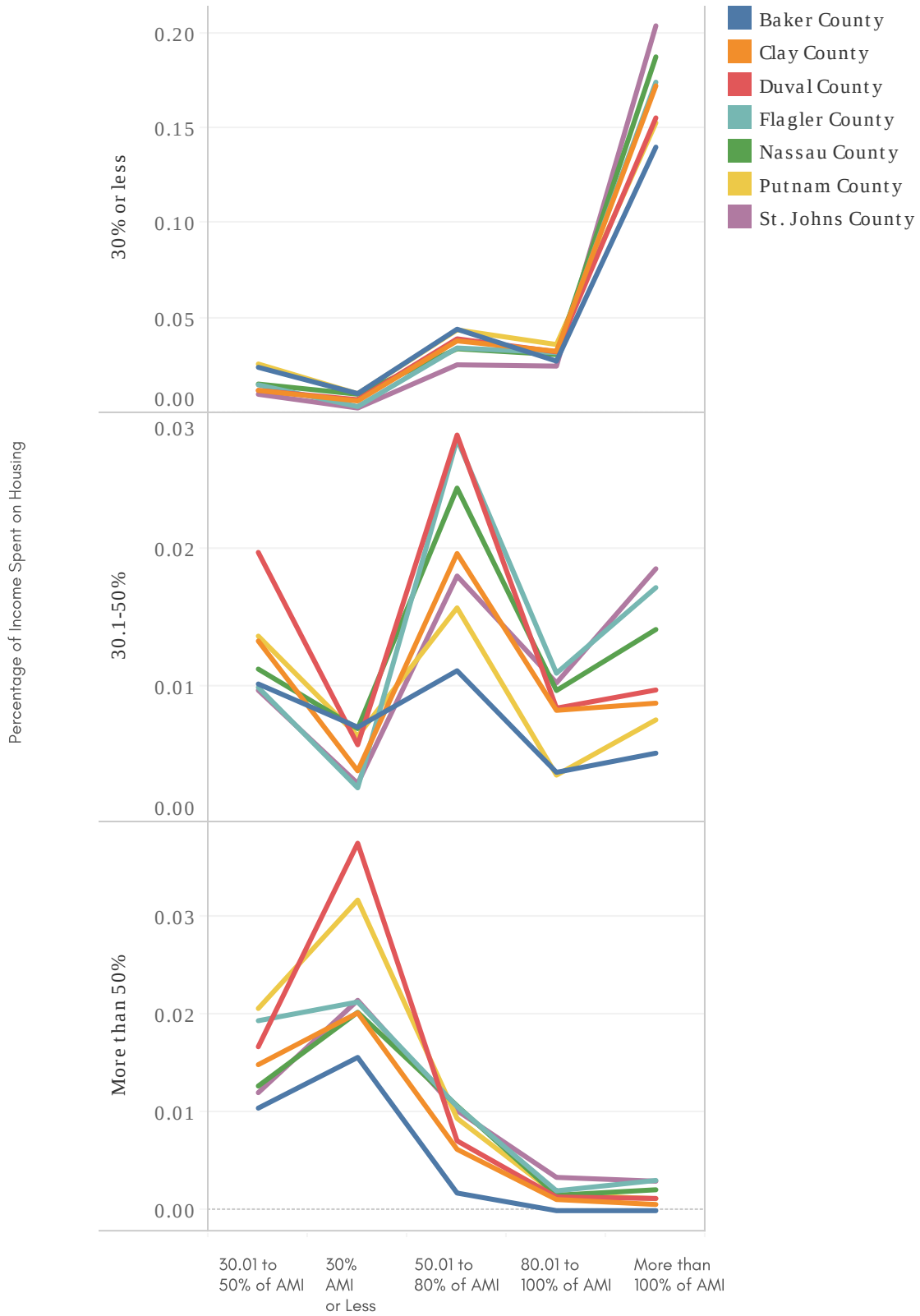

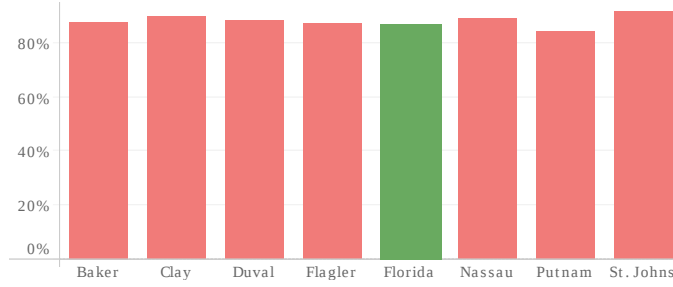

Housing Cost Burden By Income (2020)

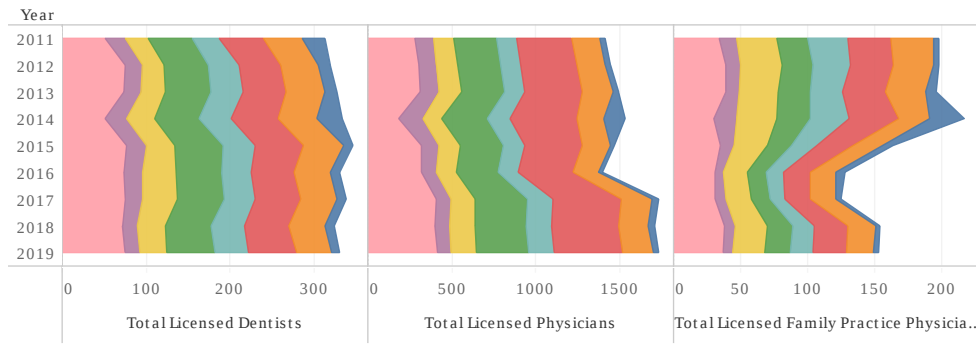
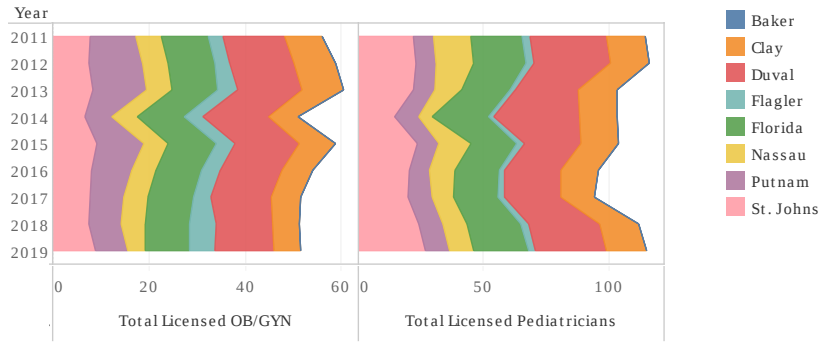

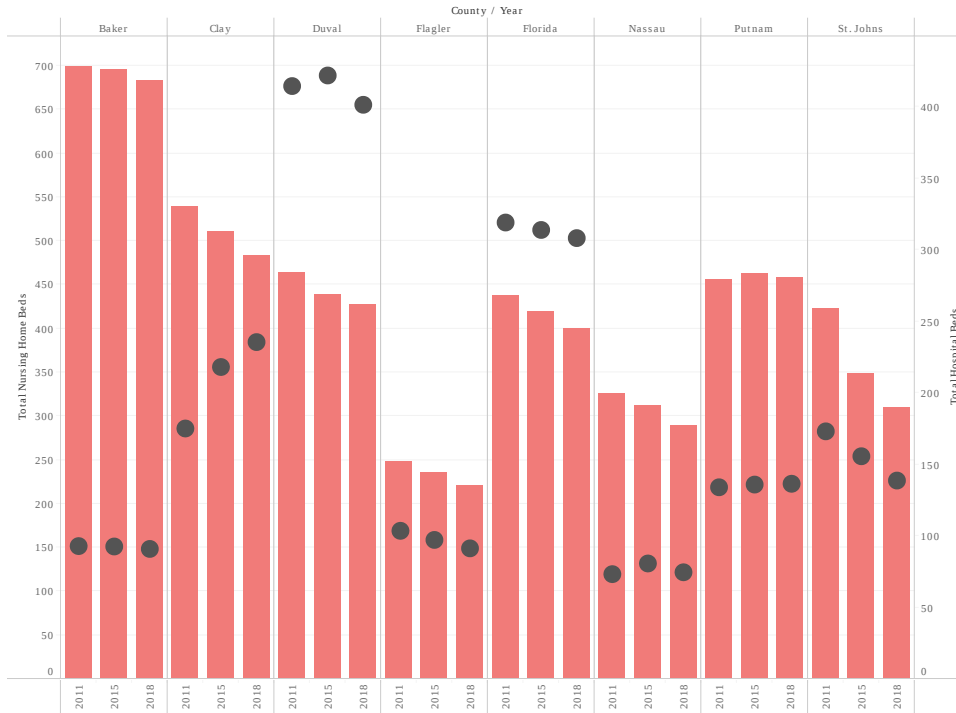


Licensed Health Providers Per Capita

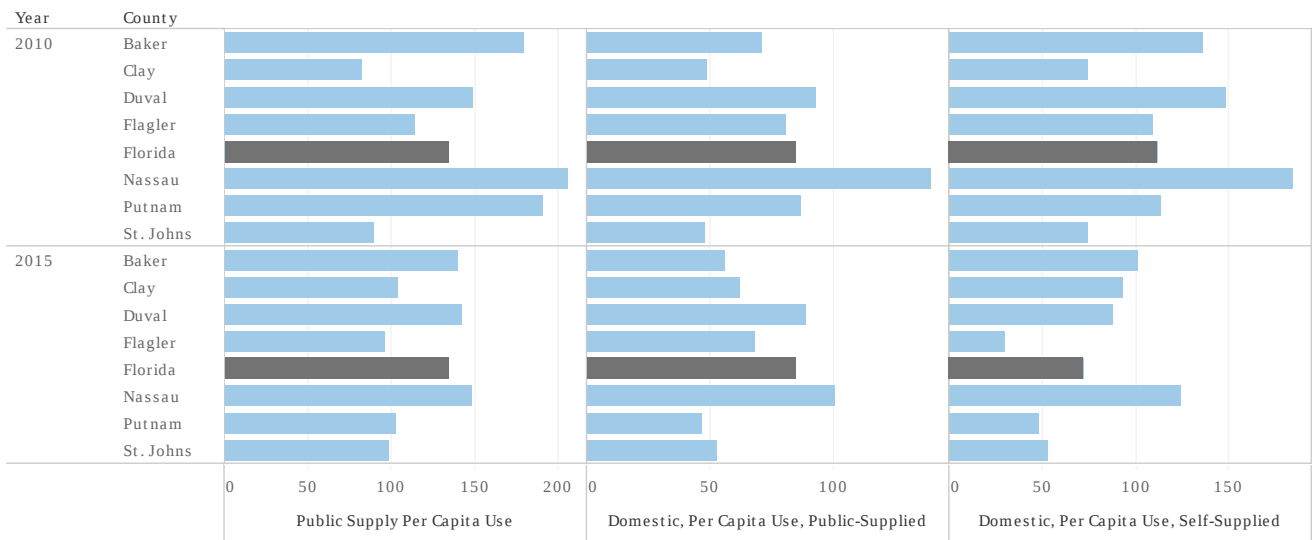

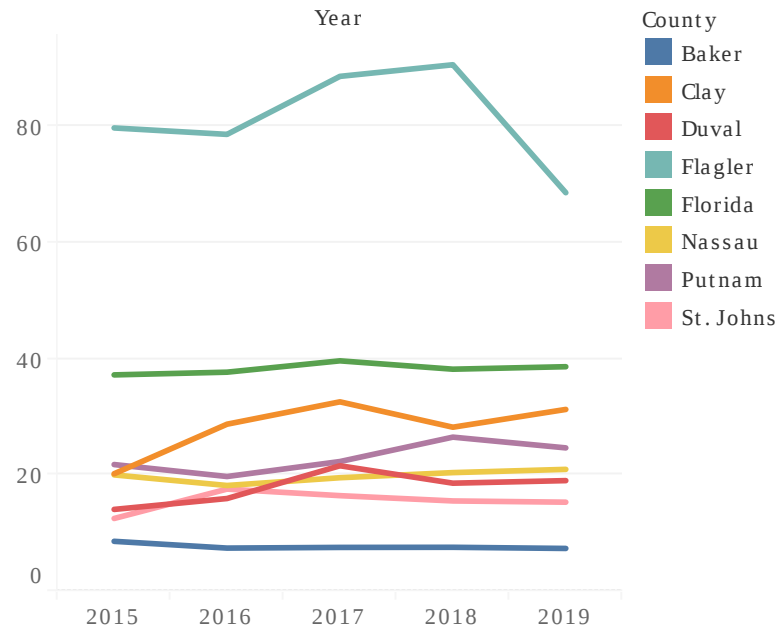

(In gallons/person/day)



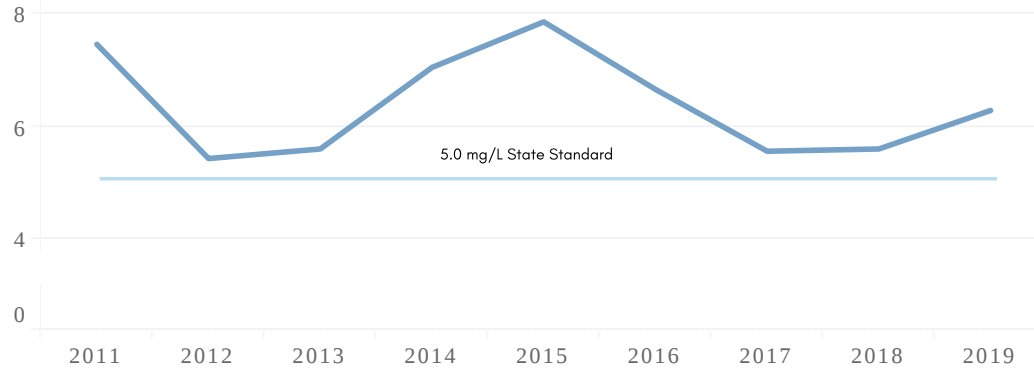
Water Reclaimed

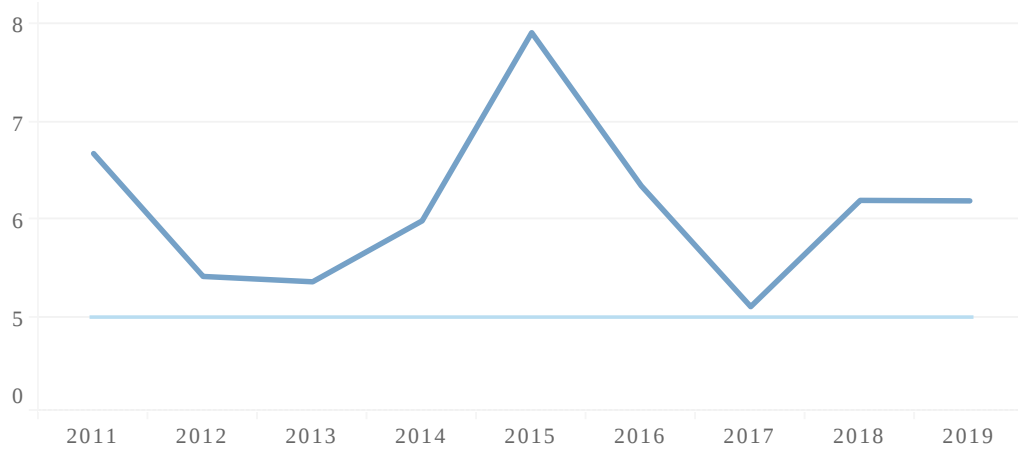

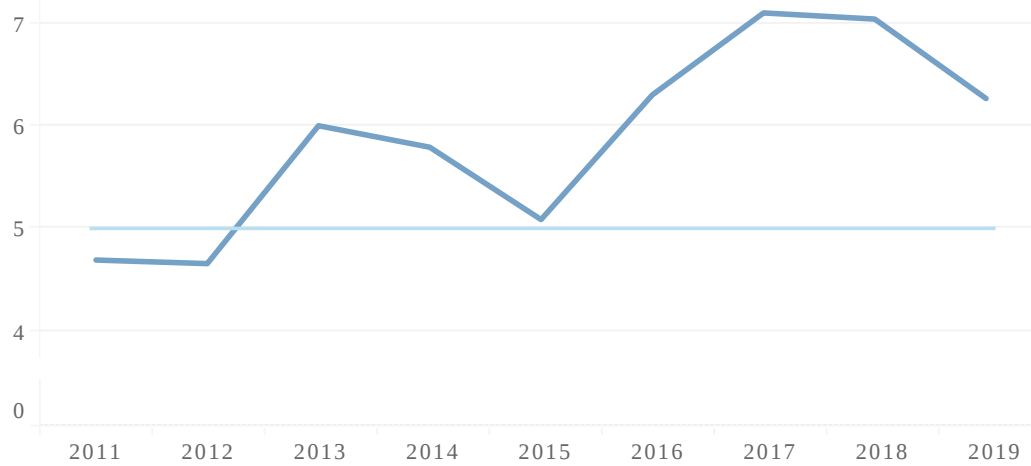

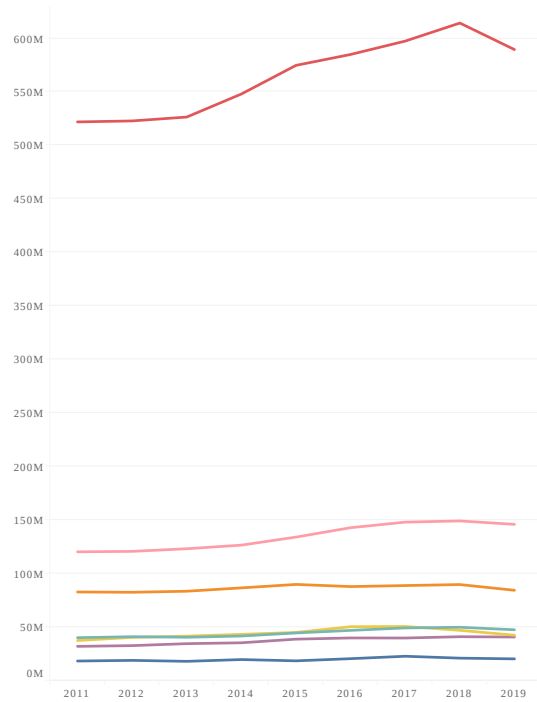

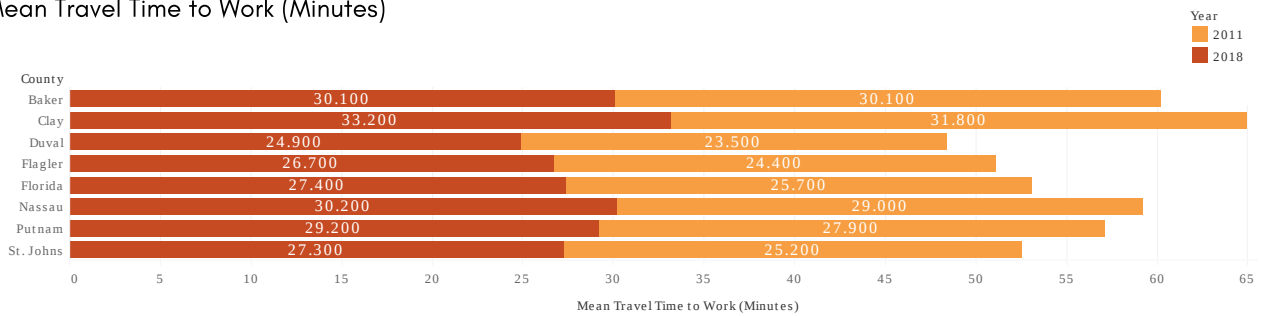
Access to High-Speed Internet % (2018)



Total Gallons of Fuel Sold

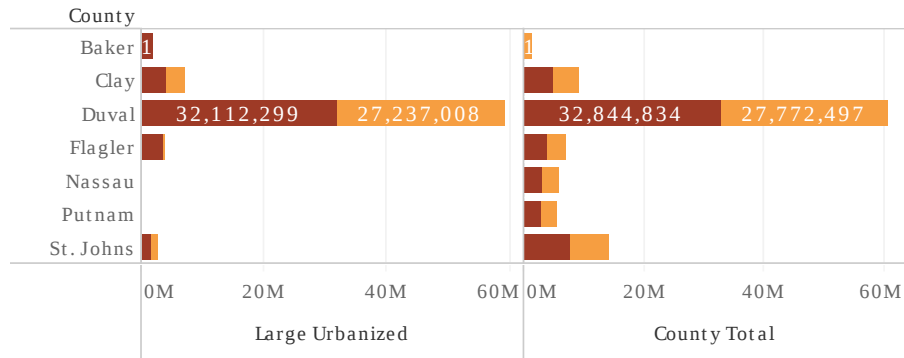
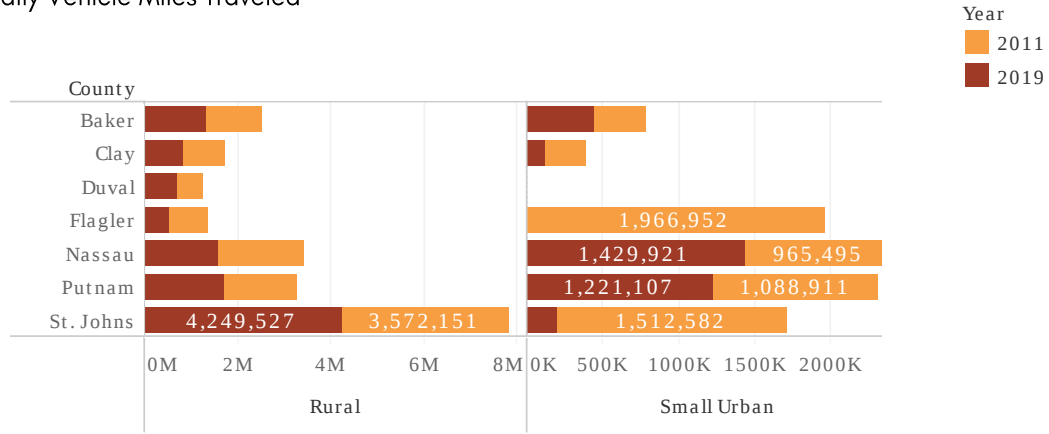


Mean Travel Time to Work (Minutes)

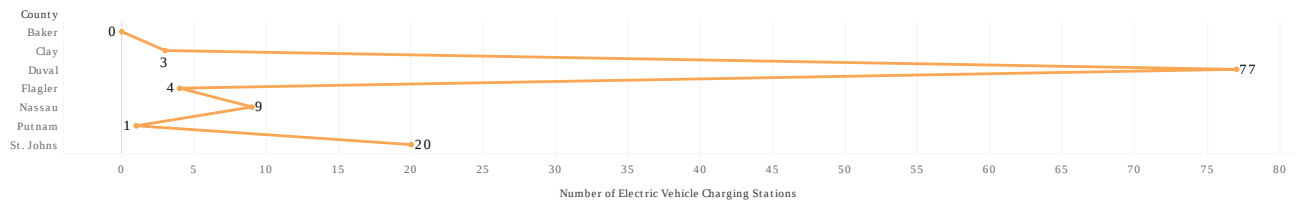
